Oil Painting Supply list

Paint: (buy the inexpensive kind – Amsterdam or VanGogh is good at Lenz – found under the counter near the cash register)

Titanium white

Cadmium yellow light or Azo

Yellow ochre

Cadmium red light

Alizarin crimson

Cerulean blue

Ultramarine blue

Prussian blue (optional)

That's right NO blacks and NO browns!

+Stretched canvas or canvas board approximately 16x20

+Turpenoid and jar with lid (silicoil jar is good)

+Paper towels or rags

+Palette - at least size 12x16 (paper tablet ok, masonite, plexiglass, etc)

+Brushes : minimum: # 8 or larger **natural hog bristle filbert brushes** to paint with and #2 to draw with

+Painting medium– Liquin gel medium or Galkyd medium (both fast drying)

+Baby oil to clean brushes (find the cheap stuff at the \$1 store)

I will have copies of the same photograph, one for each student, for the first demo/paint along.
