

## Carrie Clayden Supply list for Loosen up with Acrylic classes

- Acrylic paint- all primary colors (red, yellow, blue, white, black) along with any colors you like, I rarely do a lot of mixing.
- Gesso (get the thickest you can.
- brushes-any and all sizes but make sure to have some BIG ONES! I like cheap so I don't stress on them ( I buy bulk value pack at the hardware store)
- paint smock -or get paint on your clothes, we get messy!
- Paper towels/baby wipes -we use these for cleaning up and for brushes
- palette knife
- disposable palette paper-big as possible
- canvas (several, many different sizes, have at least 3)

### OPTIONAL

Gesso- I use Utrecht artist grade <http://www.utrechtart.com/Utrecht-Artists->

- spray bottle-I love drips
- charcoal pencil
- isopropyl alcohol-makes interesting effect
- watercolor paper
