

Carrie Clayden Supply list for Loosen up with Acrylic classes

- **Acrylic paint**- any colors that excite you (definitely white and black) I rarely do a lot of mixing. The best is Golden, then Liquitex or Sennelier. Get the best you can afford since good painting requires good paint!
- **Brushes** - any and all sizes but make sure to have some BIG ONES! I like cheap so I don't stress on them (I buy bulk value pack at the hardware store)
- **Paint Smock** - or get paint on your clothes, we get messy!
- **Paper towels/baby wipes** -we use these for cleaning up and for brushes
- **Palette Knife**
- **Disposable Palette Paper** -big as possible
- **Canvas** (several, many different sizes, have at least 5)
- **Stencils** (anything goes)
- **Squeegee or ruler**
- **Stabilo marks all pencil** black (must say paper, metal, plastic, glass on the side)
- **Golden high flow acrylic paint** (get some fun ones – these are the best!)
- **Spray bottle** (big)
- Any fun tools for mark making and any other mixed media you have like pastels or paint pens etc. Bring things that make interesting patterns and marks.

Golden Paint colors:

Quinacridone Nickel Azo Gold (MY FAVORITE COLOR-no one else has this color)
Nickel Azo yellow, Neutral Gray, Manganese Blue hue, Sap Green, Green Gold (BEST BY GOLDEN),
Turquoise (Phthalo)

Golden is the best brand for paint, I use Nova when possible to save money when I can but they don't have all of the same colors.

Stabilo pencils.
