(Santa Cruz, CA – April 27th, 2018) – From Friday, April 27th through Sunday, May 20th, the Santa Cruz Art League will present the *63rd Annual High School Show*, featuring high school artwork from students all over Santa Cruz county.

The Santa Cruz Art League is proud to present over 400 pieces from high schools all over Santa Cruz County. The art in this exhibition includes a wide variety of mediums and it has been put into six categories; photography, painting, sculpture, mixed media, drawing and print making. Our panel of local judges, who represent a broad range of different artistic styles and mediums, deliberated together to select 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place awards as well as one honorable mention award for each category.

Creating any kind of art engages the artist with the act of looking as well as representation, which can be very influential, especially in younger years, on the way that children grow up to see the world. Many artists who have had their artwork shown in the High School Show have gone on to become successful artists locally and beyond. It is encouraging and inspiring for students to be able to show their work to a wider audience. Youth art is not always telling of what the artist will end up creating as they mature, but rather it is a beginning point that shows where the artist will evolve from.
