

Materials:

Oil paints- *Paints with asterisks* are what I consider essential.*

Easels, boards to paint on, and walnut oil will be provided.

Students are welcome to bring colors they use often and enjoy. For true beginners and as a recommendation to more experienced painters, please bring the following colors (you will have better results with artist-grade colors over student grade):

*Titanium white

*Raw umber

*Burnt umber

* Burnt sienna

*Yellow ochre

*Ultramarine blue

*Cadmium orange

*Cadmium red light

*Permanent lemon or lemon

*Azo or Cadmium yellow

Violet (I love Winsor Newton Violet)

Ivory or Chromatic black

Alizarin crimson

Phthalo green

Phthalo blue

- Oil painting brushes, medium to firm bristles. Should include filberts and flats of varying sizes up to about a size 10. No need for larger.
- Paint palette- Paper palette, wood, or coated Masonite are great. Lenz art has very affordable palettes.
- Palette knife for mixing.
- Rags for wiping brushes.
- Plastic wrap or plastic bags to wrap up your brushes to take home (dirty brushes will go home with you to wash)
