## GENERAL MATERIALS LIST

Paint: buy the inexpensive kind if you can find any.

Titanium white

Cadmium yellow light

Yellow Ochre

Cadmium red light

Alizarin Crimson

Cerulean blue

Ultramarine blue

Prussian Blu (optional)

any other paint you have is fine to bring but unneeded

+canvas board or stretched, sizes from 11x14 to 16x20

+turpenoid (odorless turpentine) and a jar with a lid (silicoil jar is best)

+paper towels or rags

+plastic bag is good to bring for your dirty paint filled towels

+palette - minimum size 12x16 (paper tablet, masonite, or plexiglass all good)

+brushes: minimum: #2 *round* hogs bristle, # 6 and 8 *filbert* hogs bristle. Important: good brushes are important. You can bring the brushes you already have IF they are long-handled,

hogs bristle, and bristles not flayed out . Otherwise invest in some good ones.

+Quick dry medium such as LIquin and a small cup or jar lid to put it in

+ cardboard pizza box or other short sided box to put wet painting and/or palette in.

+baby oil to clean brushes with (\$1 store deal)
