

Supplies list for drawing class (all available at Lenz):

Drawing pad with tear-away pages: White paper, minimum size 9x12" up to 18x24", Strathmore brand

Drawing board to fit your drawing pad- other option is to use stiff masonite custom cut at Probuild Lumber

Large binder clips -2 to 4, for attaching paper to board - no need to pay for art clips! Go to an office supply store

Sketchbook- your choice, to use for notes and exercises outside class

Pencils: 4 Graphite pencils in hardness B and HB (2 each)- Faber Castell, Staedler or Blackwing brand

Colored Pencils: 2 Indigo blue, and a dark red like Tuscan red or black raspberry or crimson- Prismacolor or Faber Castell brand

Charcoal: 1 White charcoal pencil

Erasers: one pink pearl, one kneaded

Pencil sharpener: I highly recommend the Kum handheld! (around \$8), but any handheld with a SHARP blade will work

We'll be using some tinted papers later in class that we'll go over as needed

Optional but handy: small tip mechanical eraser, blending stumps, pencil extender

If you have dry media you're comfortable with or that you want to improve with, bring it along too! For example, if you're loving charcoal pencils and want more practice, we'll incorporate that into your lessons.
