

Materials List Mary Dettle Pastel Classes

Pastels:

You will need a variety of dark , medium and light soft pastels(not oil pastels) *and* hard pastels

Brands I use :

Soft pastels : Unison, Schminke, Terry Ludwig , Sennelier and Mount Vision. (get a starter set, believe me you'll get hooked and want more)

Hard Pastels : NuPastel, Rembrandt

Pastel Paper: Sanded pastel paper is the best. You can get variety pack with different colors or buy a few big sheets(Lenz) and cut them down.

A few brands I like: UArt, Pastel Premier and Art Spectrum

Other things you'll need:

Small sketchbook for taking notes and jotting down ideas

Disposable gloves

Large Backing board around 16 x 24 (foam core works great for this) or drawing board with clips

Tabletop easel (there are some to borrow in classroom)

Masking tape wide

Newsprint pad

Strathmore Toned Gray sketch paper 5.5 x 8.5

Soft Charcoal

Tombow Gray Pen Assortment or Lyra Aqua brush duo in gray tones

Paper towels

Small color wheel

Inexpensive paintbrush 1inch

Small container isopropyl alcohol 70% or higher
